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The corrected Abstract of the paper *Z. Kristallogr. NCS* 2017; 232(3): 507–509:

In the paper by Jaćimović *et al.* [*Z. Kristallogr. NCS* 2017; 232(3): 507–509] by an oversight, the crystal system of the reported structure was presented as triclinic instead of monoclinic.

C₉H₇BrN₂O, monoclinic, *C*2/*c* (no. 15), *a* = 16.255(3) Å, *b* = 4.4119(9) Å, *c* = 25.923(5) Å, β = 107.99(3)°, *V* = 1768.2(7) Å³, *Z* = 8, *R*_{gt}(*F*) = 0.0450, *wR*_{ref}(*F*²) = 0.0960, *T* = 150 K.

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
